Introduction

Infowise Random Image is a Microsoft SharePoint web part that presents a different, random image from an image library with each access to a page.

Installation

Note: as the product is installed as a SharePoint Solution, you need to install it only once, regardless of the number of your front-end servers.

Copy the installation package to one of your front-end server machine and unzip it. Double-click the Setup file and follow the on-screen instructions. You do not have to change the default settings.

Registration

If you have purchased the product, use the *Infowise Capability Dashboard* management page accessible through the *Central Administration* site. Enter the License Key under corresponding product. If no License Key is entered, the version is time-limited to 30 days. Both full and time-limited versions contain the same functionality.

Usage

The following instruction guides you step-by-step through the process of setting up a sample Infowise Random Image implementation. Your real-life settings procedure is very similar.

- Prepare an image library with at least two images. The image library can be located in the same site as the web part or any other site on the same physical server.
- Place the web part on a page. The web part is located in the Virtual Server Gallery.
- Modify web part settings and specify the site URL and the list name of the image library you intend to use. If your image library is located in the same site as the web part, you do not have to specify the site URL.
- Optionally specify image height and/or width. The default value is -1, which means that the images are not resized.
- Reload the page several times to see the images shown at random.
